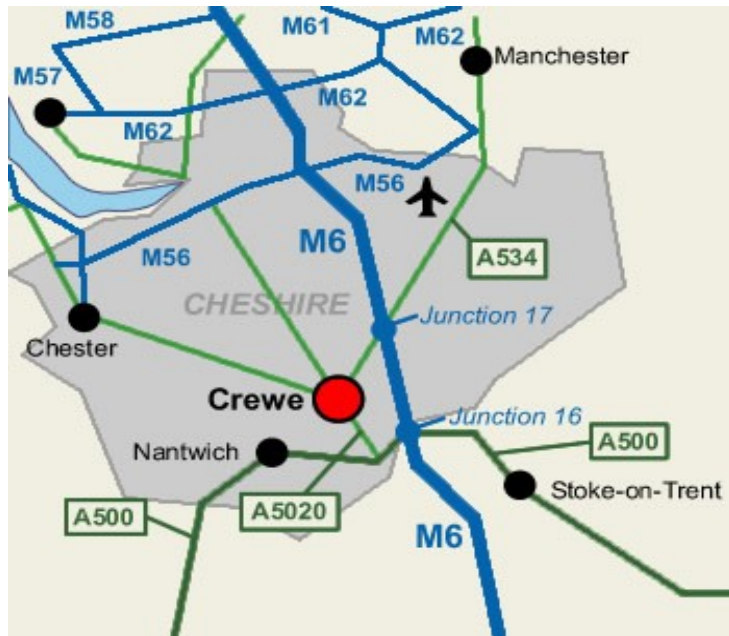
Facilities

Location

Sat Nav Postcode: CW1 5DU (for Car Park/Race HQ)

- Exit the M6 at junction 16 and take the roundabout exit signposted CREWE, Nantwich [A500]
- Take the 3rd exit off the next roundabout onto the A5020.
- Turn left at the next roundabout staying on the A5020.
- Straight over at the next roundabout.
- At the next roundabout, turn right, (4th exit) onto the A534 (Crewe Road).
- Turn left (1st exit) at the next roundabout, signposted Manchester Metropolitan University for Car Park & Race HQ.
- Race start (Electra Way) is directly opposite to MMU.



Car Parking

Parking is available courtesy of Manchester Metropolitan University at their site opposite Crewe Business Park and will be clearly marked. **Please do not park in residential streets or Electra Way**
